Notes for JOHN EASTON I:

This is Ambrose Easton's great-grandfather and my ggg-grandfather.

I'm looking for his parents names' and information on them.

I do not have a date of birth on John Easton I but comparing the columns on 1820, 1830 and 1840 census, it looks like he was born About 1790.

He probably came from Washington County, Pennsylvania to Dearborn County, Indiana before 1813 ???
(as May 8, 1813 he enlisted in the Indiana Militia).

Stephen Peters (father of the Joseph Peters that shot John Easton and some kin to John Easton?), John Buffington, and James Walker are said to have entered into Dearborn County, Indiana in 1811 from Pennsylvania. (History of Dearborn County, Indiana)

John Easton - Private and Simon Peters - Private > are both listed here

There was a fire at the Dearborn County Courthouse in 1826 and all records at that time and before were lost in the fire. So there are no marriage records, etc. before 1826. So I have not found if John Easton and Mary Wallace married in Indiana or if they married in Kentucky (since her birthplace was KY).

JOHN EASTON I was killed Christmas Day, December 25, 1840 at the home of Joseph Peters on Lower Dillsboro Road, Aurora, Dearborn County, Indiana.

Another researcher found a document copy from the Lawrenceburg Public Library in Lawrenceburg, Indiana and mailed me a copy of it :

From the book "Cotton's Keepsake" 1858 - page 398 - by Rev. Judge Aylett J. Cotton, Philom.

" Wilmington - Formerly the county seat, is located on a very high ridge, some two and a half miles northwest from Aurora. In this jail, here, Dodd hung himself, and a stranger cut his throat; and right in the jail, I once married a happy couple - a novelty. Here George Goulding hung himself in a mill; here Joseph Peters killed John Easton (should be EASTON) in an affray, was tried and acquitted, as a justifiable homicide. They were half-brothers or brothers-in-law - what a pity! Peters has an interesting family, who are often pained at the bare mention of the sad occurrence. Not at all, children; if it be your misfortune, it is not your fault, surely."

The below was transcribed from the CIRCUIT COURT *COMPLETE RECORD* BOOK - APRIL 1841 TERM - found in the basement of the Dearborn County Courthouse, Lawrenceburg, Indiana :

Pleas began and held at Wilmington in and for Dearborn County and State of Indiana before the Honorable Miles C. Egleston President Judge of the third Judicial Circuit of said State and John Livingston and Alford J. Cotton Esquire associate Judges of the Dearborn Circuit Court at the Term of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty One.

THE STATE OF INDIANA vs. JOSEPH PETERS > Indictment Manslaughter

Be it remembered that at a Dearborn Circuit Court began and held at Wilmington in and for the

County aforesaid and State of Indiana, twenty sixth day of April being the Monday of April in the year One thousand Eight hundred and forty One before the Honorable Judges aforesaid by the Oaths of John Gray, Jonathan Lewis, John Dawson, Ebenezer Roberts, John B. Clark, William S. Puto, Mahlon Brown, William Hutchen, William J. McCrary, John Ligg, Robert Fowler, Zachariah Barker, James Isaac Clark, Zedeiah A. Bouham, Elisha Bodure, and Israel Noyes, Seventeen good and lawful men discreet householders of Dearborn County who bring empaneled and sworn as Grand Jurors to enquire of and concerning all offenses committed within the body of said County, presented the following Bill of Indictment To wit; The State of Indiana, Dearborn County;

In the Dearborn Circuit Court of the term of April in the year of our Lord One thousand, Eight hundred and forty One;

Dearborn County; The Grand Jurors for the State of Indiana empannelled and sworn in the Dearborn Circuit Court to enquire in and for the body of the County of Dearborn in the name and by the authority of the State of Indiana upon their oaths present Joseph Peters on the twenty fifth day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty at the County of Dearborn aforesaid and upon JOHN EASTON in the peace of the State of Indiana then and there being feloniously and wilfully did make an assault and that he the said Joseph Peters then and there with a chair which he the said Joseph Peters in both his hands Then and there had and held the said JOHN EASTON in and upon the head of him the said JOHN EASTON then and there feloniously and wilfully did strike giving unto him the said JOHN EASTON then and there with the said chair by the stroke aforesaid in manner aforesaid upon the head of him the said JOHN EASTON one mortal wound of the length of three inches and the breadth of one inch of which said mortal wound, he the said JOHN EASTON then and there instantly died. And so the Jurors aforesaid upon their oath aforesaid do say the the said Joseph Peters hit the said John Easton then and there in manner and form aforesaid feloniously and wilfully did kill and slay contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and again the peace and dignity of the state of Indiana... John Dumont, Pros. Attorney

And whereas afterwards To wit....at the Term of April in the year 1841. To wit, the thirtieth day of April being the fifth Juridical day of said April term; Joseph Peters > Recognizance.. Murder > Comes John Dumont the attorney who presents the pleas of the State, and on his motion, it is order by the court that said recognizance be discharged."

And whereas afterwards to wit, at another day during the April Term aforesaid to wit the twelfth day of May being the fifteenth Juridical day of said of said Term comes James W. Gazlay Esq. who was specially sworn to prosecute the Pleas of the State of Indiana in this behalf and the said defendant also comes in his own proper person, and being arraigned on Said Indictment and it being demanded of him whether he is guilty or not guilty as he stands charged therein, for plea thereto; he saith he is not guilty, and for his trial he puts himself upon the Country and the Said Prosecutor doth so likewise. therefore let a jury come. whereupon the Sheriff brought before the court the following Jury To wit: Saban Bramble, Masten Dashiele, William Garrison, John Fence, John M. Cloud, Isaac Oathoudt, Abram Hyter, Servetus Tufts, David Springer, Obediah, William Dils and Benjamin Nelson; twelve good and lawful men discreet householders of the County of Dearborn, elected, tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue formed after hearing the evidence adduced in this behalf and argument of counsel, and a charge retire to their room to deliberate upon their verdict under the charge of a sworn Bailiff of this court. and afterwards returned into court the following verdict To wit. "We the Jury find the defendant not guilty as charged in this Indictment." Therefore it is considered by the Court that the said defendant as to the Indictment aforesaid go hence and be discharged.

Priest, William Dils and Benjamin Milam; twelve good & lawful men, discreet householders of the County of Dearborn, elected, tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue formed. After hearing the evidence adduced in this behalf and argument of counsel, and a charge from the Court, retired to their Room to deliberate upon their verdict under the charge of a Sworn Bailiff of this Court. And afterwards returned into Court the following verdict towit. "We the Jury find the defendant not guilty as charged in this Indictment." Therefore it is considered by the Court that the said defendant as to the Indictment aforesaid "go hence and be discharged."

--And the court now adjourned until 9 o'clock tomorrow morning.

He married (1) LUCINDA SANDERS 08 Jun 1845 in Bullitt County Ky, daughter of JAMES SANDERS and MARY NIEGLE. She was born 25 Oct 1826 in Bullitt County Ky, and died 17 May 1859 in Bullitt County Ky. He married (2) JULIA ANN HUTCHERSON 04 Dec 1860 in Bullitt County, Ky, daughter of SAMUEL HUTCHERSON and LOUISA CHEERY. She was born 16 Jan 1838 in KY, and died 21 Jan 1909 in Aurora, Dearborn County, IN.

Notes for JOHN T. EASTON II:

This is Ambrose Easton's grandfather and my gg-grandfather.

Perhaps after his father John Easton was killed December 25, 1840 in Aurora, Indiana, John Easton II and his mother Mary and brother James left Dearborn County Indiana and moved to Bullitt County, Ky. as they appear on the 1850 and 1860 census in Bullitt County. It appears his two brothers had already been in Bullitt County----as brother David Easton married Mary A. Sanders on 3 Dec 1835 in Bullitt County, Ky. and brother Robert Easton married Elizabeth Sanders on 29 Nov 1838 in Bullitt County also . The 1850 census (details below) shows the mother of John Easton II as "Mary age 51 female" and living in the household with he and Lucinda and their 2 children. The 1860 census (details below) shows the mother of John II Easton as "Mary age 64 female" living in the household with he and his 2nd wife Julia and his 7 children.

John Easton II (b 1822) himself definitely moved from Dearborn County, Indiana to Bullitt County, Kentucky sometime after 25 Dec 1840 and the 8 Jun 1845 (as on 8 Jun 1845, he married Lucinda Sanders in Bullitt County, Ky.) and his mom either traveled with him or she joined him there before the 1850 Census in Bullitt County, Ky

The Sanders and Easton homes in Bullit County Ky are no longer standing. A subdivision was put in on the property in the late 1960s and early 1970s.

1862 -For the consideration of \$250.00 paid David Easton and Maria his wife sell a tract of land in Jefferson Co. conveyed to them by James Q Sanders dec'd(Lucinda's father) to John Easton. Wits: R. F. Samuels. David does not sign deed - only Maria (X) Easton signs but when it is recorded 17 Apr 1862 it says the deed is acknowledged by both David and Maria. [Bullitt Co. Deed Bk P p. 132]

In making this settlement I have not allowed the Guardian any commission although I am satisfied she has had a great deal of trouble and some expense in her attention to her wards estate nor have I charged her interest. The Gov. of U.S. allowed her wards at the rate of 72.00 per year from 1865 but from an

examination of her certificate, she was not paid until 1869 & then only received \$509.33, having paid fees at Wasington & some other expenses in procuring her wards claim. I have personal knowledge of the procurement of this claim, & of her trouble and know the condition of the Gdn. in a pecuniary sense, and I consider that \$500.00 is a small allowance to her for the services expense the above allowed her. The Gdn. has exhibited to me two notes on Wm. SANDERS of \$100.00 each, also note on Henry SANDERS for 180.00 also note on Henry SANDERS for 20.00 & one note on A. BROOKS for 30.00, making without counting interest in notes \$430.00. These notes seem to be from the guardian Statements obtained by her ward's money and are about the amount found due by the Guardian. W.
